OPEN LETTER TO RACINE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY PATRICIA HANSON

Dear District Attorney Hanson,

H.O.T. Government wrote to you on January 16th, 2022 openly requesting you to act on the charges referred to you and your office concerning the Wisconsin Elections Commission (WEC) Commissioners. As of today neither H.O.T. Government nor the people of Racine County, whom you serve, have heard from you or seen you act on the referred charges from the Racine County Sheriff's Office (RCSO). We understand by your lack of action that you and your office refuse to issue and file complaints charging the commissioners with the crimes referred to you by the RCSO.

You, in the execution of your office, have discretionary power to refuse to issue a complaint or charges. However, that discretion is not unlimited; "Guidelines for the exercise of prosecutorial discretion are explored in Standard 3.9 of the American Bar Association, Standards for Criminal Justice Relating to the Prosecution Function..." [State v. Karpinski, 285 NW 2d 729 - Wis: Supreme Court 1979 at 609]. Quoting RCSO Officer Lt. Michael Luell from November 10th, 2021; "A government that passes laws, is a government that must follow the law".

H.O.T. Government for the second time, openly requests you act on the charges referred by the RCSO or openly state that you refuse to issue the complaints and charges referred to you by the RCSO.

We stand for Honest, Open, and Transparent Government that is accountable to the people it governs by their consent.
